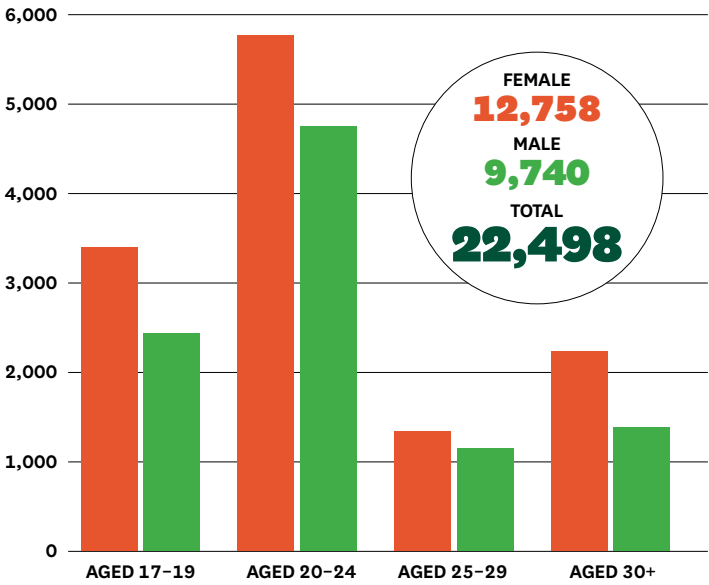

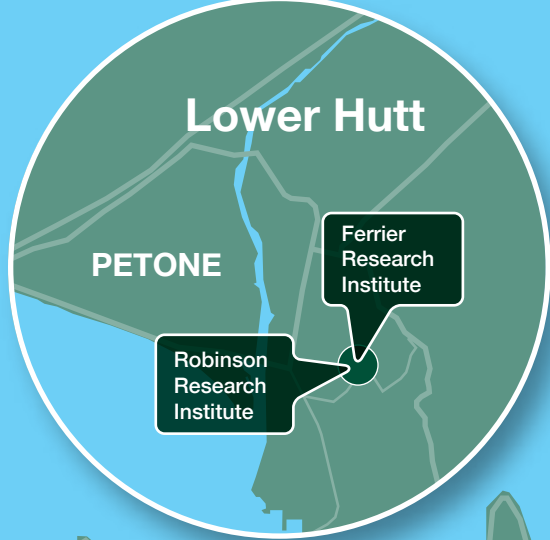
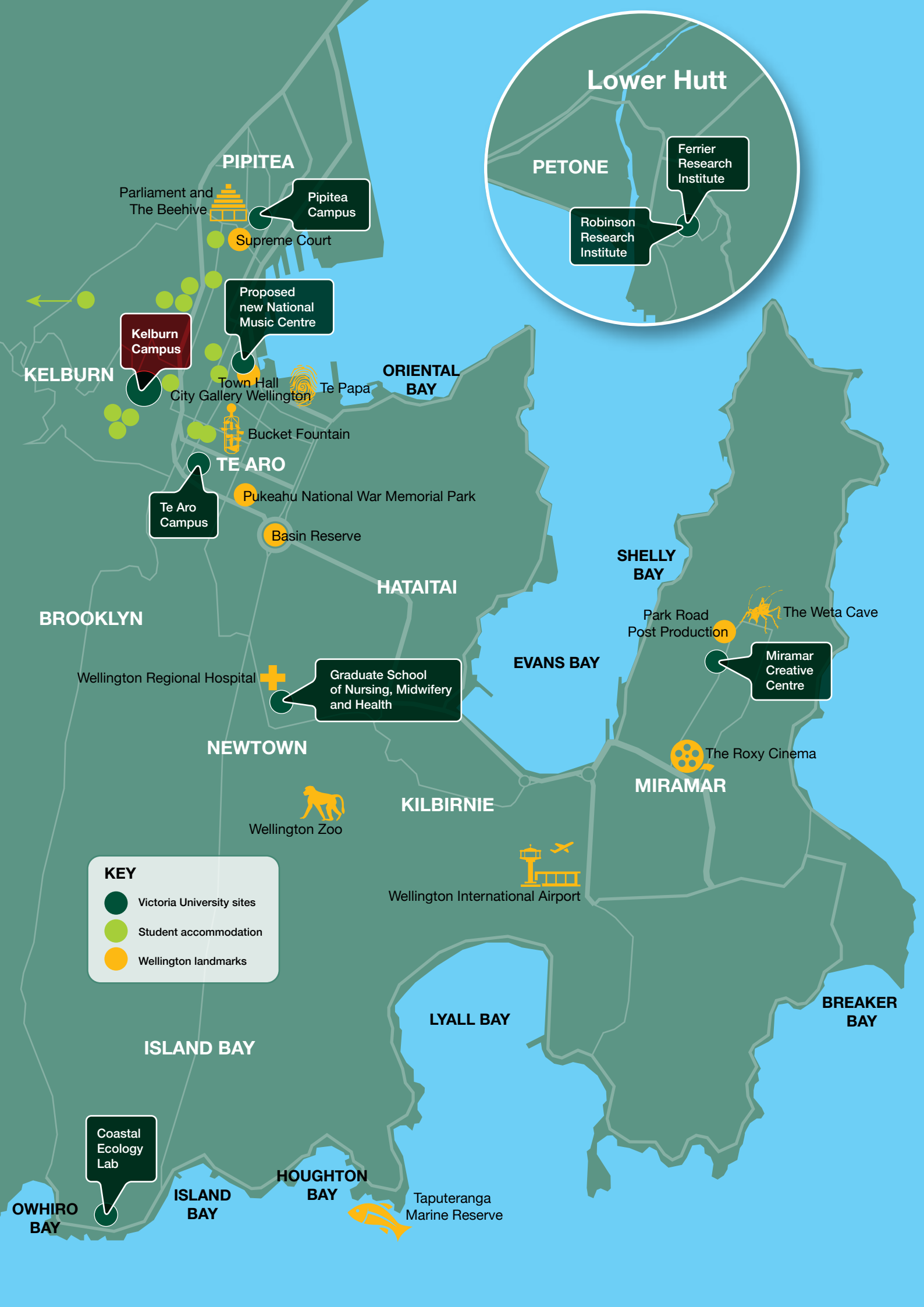
Student distribution¹
