Gender Diversity in the New Zealand and Australian Craft Beer Industries



Craft beer is a growing industry with significant impact on local economies, tourism, culture and the beer industry more broadly. Much of the popular discourse around craft beer celebrates the industry for diversifying beer's taste, style, branding and consumption as a cultural object, especially compared to mainstream macro-breweries. However, there remains a dearth of knowledge about industry diversity in terms of brewery/brand owners - that is, the people behind the production process who make more than just beer but the cultures and communities that beer promotes. This project attempted to quantify the diversity of craft beer brands across New Zealand and Australia, with an eye towards gender identity, of which no information currently exists. The research involved a demographic survey of craft beer companies, their

owners, head brewers and board members (where applicable).


Craft brewing contributed roughly \$397 million NZD to the AUS GDP


