Notes

- → To secure a place in a hall you need to pay a deposit made up of an Administration Fee, Residential Activity Fee and a Security Deposit (refundable if all obligations met).
- → The Student Allowance rate is based on \$383.33, which includes the accommodation benefit of \$60 and maximum living away from home allowance rate of \$323.33 for a student under the age of 24.
- → The Student Loan rate is based on \$323.43, the maximum living costs available.
- → Additional items to include in your budget are toiletries, cell phone and entertainment. \$70 per week on average, \$2,660 over 38 weeks. 222 Willis is not a catered hall, so you will also need to buy your own food, of which costs will vary.
