## ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

You can go on an exchange at any time in your second or third year. If you go in your final trimester, you'll need to have completed the minimum core requirements prior to leaving and have done at least half of your 300-level major, minor, and degree requirements at Victoria University of Wellington.

## INTERESTED IN EXCHANGE? HERE ARE YOUR NEXT STEPS:

### 1. ATTEND AN INFORMATION SESSION

### 2. MEET WITH YOUR FACULTY STUDENT ADVISOR

### 3. RESEARCH POSSIBLE EXCHANGE UNIVERSITIES

To submit your application online, you need to prepare a preliminary study plan for each of your three university preferences as well as a budget.
