ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

You can normally go on an exchange in your second or third year of study. Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Biomedical Science students normally need to complete at least half their 300-level major and degree requirements at Victoria University of Wellington before graduating.

POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS

Postgraduate diplomas, the first year of a research Master's programme or a semester of a taught Master's are eligible for an exchange. Exchange is not available for the one-year Bachelor of Science with Honours and Bachelor of Biomedical Science with Honours programmes.

Due to an intensive programme structure, it is not possible to go on an exchange as part of the Postgraduate Diploma in Geographic Information Science and the Masters in Geographic Information Science.

INTERESTED IN EXCHANGE? HERE ARE YOUR NEXT STEPS:

1. ATTEND AN INFORMATION SESSION

2. MEET WITH YOUR FACULTY STUDENT ADVISOR

3. RESEARCH POSSIBLE EXCHANGE UNIVERSITIES

When submitting your application you must select three universities and be prepared to go to any one of your choices, as availability is often limited.

4. PREPARE YOUR APPLICATION

To submit your application online, you need to prepare a preliminary study plan for each of your three university preferences as well as a budget.
