

2020 Graduate Destinations Survey Terms and Conditions—Cash Prize Draws



The prize draws

The winners will be selected by random draw from the participants who have completed the 2020 Te Herenga Waka—Victoria University of Wellington Graduate Destinations Survey questionnaire.

The prizes

There are three \$150 cash prizes and one cash prize of \$500.

Winners will be drawn on the following dates:

- Monday 28 September 2020 (\$150)
- Monday 5 October 2020 (\$150)
- Monday 12 October 2020 (\$150)

Participants who have completed the survey by midnight, on the Sunday prior to each draw date, will be included in the draw the following Monday. Participants will also be entered into any remaining draws. The earlier that you complete the survey, the more chances you have of winning.

The final draw for \$500 will be made the Monday after the survey close date on Sunday 18 October 2020.

Winners will be notified by email or phone.

Prize draw terms and conditions:

1. These terms and conditions relate to the Victoria University of Wellington (the “University”), ‘Draw for completing the Graduate Destinations Survey.’ By entering the draw, the entrant agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions. The prize draw is run by the Careers and Employment Service at the University.
2. The prize draw opens on Monday 21 September 2020 and will close at midnight on Sunday 18 October 2020.
3. To enter the prize draw, the entrant must complete and submit the online survey.
4. The \$150 prizes will be drawn on Monday 28 September, Monday 5 October and Monday 12 October. The \$500 prize will be drawn on Monday 19 October. The winners will be notified by email or phone.
5. The winners are chosen at random by the University’s Careers and Employment Service.
6. The prize draw is open to the University’s graduates who complete the survey.
7. Entries must comply with these terms and conditions and be received by the closing date and time. Failure to do so will disqualify the entry.
8. The University accepts no responsibility for any entries that are not received, incomplete, illegible, corrupted or which fail to be submitted by the closing date and time. Proof of submission is not proof of receipt.
9. The University reserves the right to verify the validity of entries, to disqualify any entrant or to cancel or amend the draw or these terms and conditions at any time for any reason, without prior notice.
10. In the event of any dispute regarding these terms and conditions, conduct, results and all other matters relating to the prize draw (including the selection of the winners), the decision of the University is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
11. By entering the prize draw the entrant agrees that if they are a winner they will participate in and cooperate with reasonable publicity requirements of the University.
12. Failure to claim a prize within 14 days may result in disqualification and selection of an alternative winner.
13. The Prize is non-transferable and there is no alternative or any form of credit.
14. The entrant understands that the information they provide is being collected for the purposes described in, and will be used in accordance with, the University’s Privacy Notice (available at www.wgtn.ac.nz/privacy).
