PART 1: COURSES (ELECTIVES)

Complete four elective courses from across the engineering school, choosing to specialise in a particular area within electronics, networking, renewable energy, software, or computer science.

PART 2*: RESEARCH OR INDUSTRY-BASED PROJECT

Undertake a large university-based research project or an industry-based project.

*Entry into Part 2 of the course requires at least a B- average in Part 1 (or special permission from the head of school).
