

# Our returnable bag initiative



The Victoria University of Wellington Fruit and Vegetable Co-operative is proudly plastic-bag free, with all orders packed into our returnable fabric bags.

To help us stay plastic-bag free, we'll need your support in returning our bags to us within seven days so we can pack them again with more fresh produce.



## How our returnable bags work

- All returnable fabric bags belong to the University's Fruit and Vegetable Co-op and are only for use for your fruit and vegetable co-op order.
- When you get your order home, unpack the bags as soon as possible, turn them inside out and shake out any leaves, and if necessary, hang them up to dry—you don't need to wash them.
- Return our fabric bags within seven days, either at the next co-op order collection or at one of our returnable bag drop-off points on campus:
  - Kelburn campus: VUWSA Kelburn office, Level 4, Student Union Building
  - Pipitea campus: Reception desk, Te Taunaki, Mezzanine floor, Rutherford House
  - Te Aro campus: book return slot, Architecture and Design Library main entrance, Level 1, Vivian Street
- You are welcome to transfer your produce directly into your own bags when you collect your order.
