ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

You can normally go on an exchange in your second year or, with faculty approval, in your third year of study. For a professional programme such as engineering, you can't go in your final trimester as this is your project year and honours year.

POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS

Postgraduate diplomas, first year of the Master of Computer Science and Master of Science in Computer Science or Electronic and Computer Systems are eligible for an exchange. Exchange is not available for Master of Engineering students as this is a research degree.
