Sikhs in Gallipoli

Recent research has revealed that three times as many Indian troops served in the Gallipoli campaign as previously thought. They fought alongside Anzacs who developed a close comradeship with them - unusual for the time. About a quarter of the Indian troops were Sikhs, whose story has at last been told.

Professor Peter Stanley of University of New South Wales, Canberra, who recently published the first book on Indians on Gallipoli, *Die in Battle, Do Not Despair: The Indians on Gallipoli, 1915* (Solihull: Helion, 2015), will give an illustrated talk, discussing the Sikh experience of and contribution to the Gallipoli campaign.
