2 KO NGĀ WHĀINGA

- 2.1 Ko te whakapakari i te reo mā te ako, mā te wānanga, mā te wetewete, me te whakamātau te whāinga matua o Wana Tū te Wana.

2.2 Kia mārama koe i ngā whāinga o te karaihe nei:

Kia tutuki pai te tauira i te karaihe nei:

 - Kua mātau te tauira ki ngā kupu, ki ngā kīwaha, me ngā whakataukī e akona ana i te karaihe nei.
 - Kua waia te tauira ki ngā pānui o te karaihe nei. Ka mōhio te tauira ki ngā kōrero ō roto, ka taea hoki te whakapākehā, te whakarāpopoto hoki i ētahi wāhanga.
 - Kua mātau te tauira ki ngā tū rerenga māmā, me te whakakāhoretanga hoki o aua tū rerenga. Ka mōhio hoki ia ki ngā horopaki e tika ana, me ngā āhuatanga o aua tū rerenga.
 - Kua mataara te tauira ki ngā hapa, me ngā hē noa o te reo e tātarihia i te karaihe, ka mōhio hoki me pēwhea te whakatika.
 - Kua waia haere te tauira ki te wetewete i āna ake mahi, e pā ana ki te tika o te reo me ngā ariā hoki.
 - Kua taea e te tauira te whakamāori, te whakapākehā rānei i te reo tuhituhi me te reo kōrero, e aro haere ana ki te āhua ūkawa, ki te āhua ūpaki rānei o te reo.
 - Kua mōhio te tauira me pēwhea te whakarite tuhinga, te tohu hoki i ngā pūtake rangahau e ai ki ngā tikanga tuhituhi o Te Kawa a Māui.
 - Kua tika, kua māori haere te whakahua kupu i te reo Māori.
 - Kua mātau te tauira ki te reo Māori hei reo kōrero i te wheako o te karaihe.

4.1 Ko ngā akoranga nui

E toru tekau mā tahi ngā akoranga nui o MAOR 121. Me mātua tae-ā-tinana atu te tauira ki ngā akoranga nui e rua tekau mā toru, neke atu rānei.

E toru hāora te roanga o ia akoranga nui. I te Rāhina, te Rāapa me te Rāpare tātou e hui ai. Ka tīmata i te 10am, ā ka mutu i te 1pm.

4.2 Ko ngā akoranga whāiti

Tekau ngā akoranga whāiti mō tēnei karaīhe. E rua hāora ia wiki te roa. Ka tīmata ngā akoranga whāiti hei te wiki tuarua. Me mātua tae-ā-tinana te tauira ki ngā akoranga whāiti e whitu, neke atu rānei.

4.3 Ko te noho marae

Kotahi te noho marae. Hei te rā 7 o Hakihea te noho e tū ai. Me mātua tae-ā-tinana mai ia tauira ki te noho. Tekau mā rima tāra te utu o te noho (\$15). Hei te akoranga nui ka āta whakamāramahia ngā mahi o te noho marae.

4.4 Ko te nui o ngā mahi

Kia 24 ngā hāora ia wiki (ngā akoranga nui, whāiti hoki, me te mahi kāinga).

5 KO NGĀ AROMATAWAI

5.1 Ko ngā mahi

Me tuku ngā tuhituhi katoa ki te pouaka aromatawai kei te tari o Te Kawa a Māui, ki 50 Kelburn Parade. Kaua e tukuna atu ki te Pūkenga, ki tōna rūma, ki te kaituruki rānei.

5.2 Ko ngā aromatawai

Kei roto nei ngā kōrero katoa i tēnei mahere mahi mō ngā aromatawai o Wana Tū te Wana. Kei roto i te pukapuka pānui o MAOR 121 ētahi atu rauemi hei āwhina i a koe. Waihoki, ka whakamāramahia ngā aromatawai ki ngā akoranga nui, whāiti hoki. Ki te kore koe e mārama, pātai atu ki te Pūkenga.

Ko te tikanga o ngā aromatawai, he whakaatu he pēhea rawa tō tipu, tō mārama e pā ana ki ngā whāinga o te karaihe nei (titiro ki 2.2).

Ko ngā whiwhinga mō te karaihe nei ka whakaritea pēnei:

Ko ngā mahi aromatawai-ā-roto 70%

Ko te whakamātautau whakamutunga 30%

5.3 Ko ngā mahi aromatawai-ā-roto

5.4 Ko ngā mahi-ā-rōpū

E rua ngā aromatawai-ā-rōpū o tēnei karaihe, arā ko te mahinga o te Whakaari me te mahinga o te Tūmahī Hōtaka. Mā ēnei aromatawai e puta ai tētahi māka motuhake mā ia tauira. Me huri ki ngā kupu a te whare wānanga nei e tautoko ana i tēnei kaupapa: *'The University recognises that group work, when used appropriately, can be a valuable teaching strategy that contributes to students' learning and the development of communication and team work skills. Group work refers to learning activities on which students' work together to produce a report or complete a specific task.'*

6 KO NGĀ TOHUTOHU

6.1 Tuhingaroa

E rua ngā tuhingaroa. Ka wānangahia ngā kaupapa me ngā whāinga o ia tuhingaroa ki roto i ngā akoranga nui. Mēnā he pātai anō tāu, pātai atu ki te Pūkenga.

E whitu rau e rima tekau (750) ngā kupu o Tuhingaroa 1. Kotahi mano e rua rau e rima tekau (1250) ngā kupu o Tuhingaroa 2. Kia mōhio koutou, koinei ngā kaupapa tuhituhi e whai ake nei:

Tuhingaroa 1: Taku whanaketanga

Tuhingaroa 2: He parekura/He aituā

Me hāngai tonu ki ngā ture a Te Kawa a Māui mō te whakatakoto tuhituhi.

6.2 Whakaari

Ka tū tēnei aromatawai ki te noho marae. Ka mahi-ā-rōpū ngā tauira, whakarite ai i tētahi whakaari. Mā te Pūkenga ngā kaupapa e whakamārama atu, māna hoki ngā rōpū e whakarite.

6.3 Whakamātautau

Ka tū tēnei whakamātautau i roto i te akoranga nui ā te wiki tuarima. Iwa tekau meneti te roa. Ka āta whakamāramahia tēnei aromatawai i roto i ngā akoranga nui.

6.4 Tūmahi hōtaka

Ka tū tēnei aromatawai ā te wiki tuawaru. Mō tēnei aromatawai, ka mahi-ā-rōpū ngā tauira, whakarite ai i tētahi hōtaka kawepūrongo. Mā te Pūkenga tēnei mahi e whakamārama atu, māna hoki ngā rōpū e whakarite.

6.5 Rangahau/kauhau

Ka tū tēnei aromatawai ā te wiki tekau, i ngā akoranga. Mō tēnei aromatawai, ka rangahau te tauira mō te kaupapa nei, arā ko ngā kōrero tāhuhu o tōu iwi. Kātahi ka tū te tauira, tuari ai i āna mahi me ngā hua i puta mai. Kia waru meneti, tae atu ki te tekau meneti te roanga o te kauhau. Mā te rangahau me te āta whakaharatau tēnei mahi e oti pai ai.

6.6 Whakamātautau whakamutunga

Hei te wiki o te rā 15 o Hui-tanguru te whakamātautau whakamutunga. E rua haora te roa. Tōna tikanga, ka wātea te tauira mō te wiki aromatawai katoa, mai i te 15 ki te 20 o Hui-tanguru 2010.

7 TE PŪTAHI ATAWHAI

Mēnā ka hiahia āwhina koutou ki te ako i te reo, he hoa kōrero rānei māu, kei konei te kaupapa Tuakana/Teina. Hei te tīmatanga o te karaihe, me kōrero ki te Pūkenga.

8 MO TE HUNGA HAUĀ

He ture tā te Whare Wānanga e pā ana ki ngā tāngata hauā. He ture mō ngā whakamātautau me ērā atu o ngā aromatawai. Me kōrero ki te Pūkenga mēnā ka whaihua tēnei ki a koe.

9 KO NGĀ MAHI

Me ū ki ēnei ture katoa kia āhei ai te tauira ki te eke ki te taumata tuarua:

- me tae atu ki ngā akoranga nui 23, neke atu rānei
- me tae atu ki ngā akoranga whāiti e whitu, neke atu rānei
- me mahi ngā aromatawai katoa
- me mahi te whakamātautau whakamutunga
- me eke ki te 50% mō ngā aromatawai katoa.

10 KO NGĀ WHIU

Ki te kore e tutuki i a koe ngā whakaritenga mō ia aromatawai, kāore koe e hipa i tēnei karaihe. Kāore koe e āhei ki te uru ki te taumata tuarua.

Me tuku ngā tuhituhi, me mahi ngā mahi i te rā kua whakaritea. Ka tangohia 5% mō ia rā ka tae tōmuri mai. Ka tekau ngā rā ā muri i te rā tuku, kāore te mahi e whai māka. Ko te rā 15 o Hui-tanguru te rā whakamutunga kia tukuna mai he mahi aromatawai. Mēnā he take e whakararu ana i a koe, kōrero ki te Pūkenga, māna tonu e whakarite tētahi atu whaiwāhi māu hei tuku i tāu mahi.

11 KO NGĀ RĀTAKA - WĀHANGA TUATAHI-TUARUA

He whakamārama tēnei o ngā tūmahī mō ia wiki. Āta pānuihia, kua tohungia ngā rā tuku mahi me ngā aromatawai hoki. Kua tohungia hoki ngā kōrero hei pānui mā koutou, hei mahi i ngā akoranga nui. Ko te tumanako ka raupapatia pēnei, heoi, ki te neke te raupapa o ngā pānui, ka whakamāramahia i roto i ngā akoranga nui. Kāore he karaihe hei te rā 4, me te rā 25 hoki o Kohi-tātea.
