For the **PGCertTESOL** you will do four core courses (two from Strand 1 and one each from Strands 2 and 3).

For the **MAppLing**, you'll complete LALS 540 and LALS 541, and 150 further points from the table above. For the **PGDipAppLing**, you'll complete LALS 540 and LALS 541 and 90 further points from the table. For the **PGCertAppLing**, you'll complete LALS 540 and/or LALS 541 and further courses from the table to make up 60 points.
