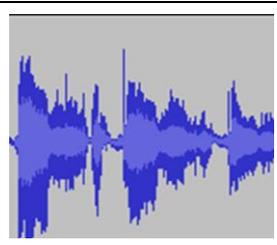

# Recording your voice

## What is Audacity?

- A software tool for **creating** and **editing** voice recordings.
- It is installed on all LLC computers.
- It is **free to download** on your home computer, see overleaf for instructions.
- You can save your recording as an **mp3 file** and email it or copy it on your audio device.

## Launching Audacity

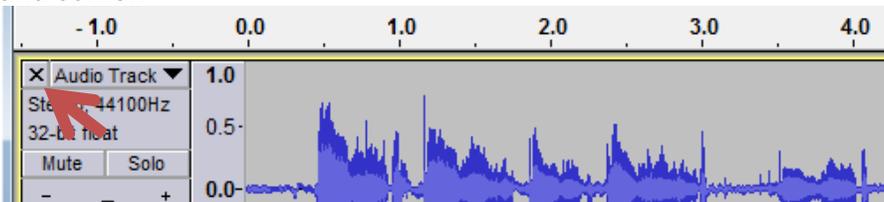
- 1 Log into a computer at the LLC and click on the **LLC Software** folder on the Desktop.
- 2 Click on **@Be Creative** folder.
- 3 Double-click the **Audacity** icon.

## Basic controls

<p><b>PLAY</b> Click to play back audio.</p>	<p><b>RECORD</b> Click to record audio (will start new track)</p>	<p><b>SELECTION TOOL</b> Use to select then cut/copy or delete sections of your recording</p>	<p><b>MICROPHONE VOLUME</b> Adjust to control level of volume</p>
<p><b>PAUSE</b> Click while recording to take a break. Then click again to continue recording on the same track.</p>	<p><b>STOP</b> Click when you are finished recording a track. New recordings will go on new tracks.</p>	<p><b>ZOOM TOOL</b> Use to zoom in and out on wave forms (useful when editing)-note how the time scale changes!</p>	<p><b>HEADPHONE VOLUME</b> Adjust to control level of volume</p>

## Checking your settings (test-recording)

- 1 Put on the **headset** and fold out the **microphone**.
- 2 Click **RECORD** and **speak** into the microphone.
  - Blue waves will form —if they are very flat, increase the microphone volume.
  - If there are no waves at all (only a flat line), the microphone may be muted or not 'seen' by Audacity. Refer to the instruction sheet '*No sound? Microphone not working?*' for troubleshooting instructions or ask for help at the counter.
- 3 When finished with the test-recording, click **STOP**, then **PLAY** to listen to what you've recorded.
- 4 **Adjust** the microphone volume if necessary.
- 5 To start afresh, **delete the test-recording** audio track by clicking on the **x** symbol in the top left-hand corner.

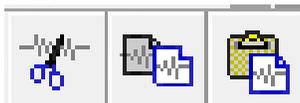


## Doing your recording

- 1 Make sure you are calm and comfortable. Sit upright to sound clear and confident.
- 2 Have your text for recording ready and in front of you. It is best to read it off the screen, so that you're not looking downwards.
- 3 When you're ready, click **RECORD**.
- 4 To take a break, click **PAUSE**. Click **PAUSE** again to continue.
- 5 When you are finished, click **STOP**.
- 6 If you realize that you would need to continue recording, **click at the end of the first track** and click on **RECORD** again. This will start a new track. You can later merge the tracks together.

## Editing your recording

- To **delete** a section of the track: highlight using the selection tool, then press the Delete button on the keyboard.
- To **cut/copy** and **paste** sections of the track: use the selection tool to highlight the section, then use the buttons below:



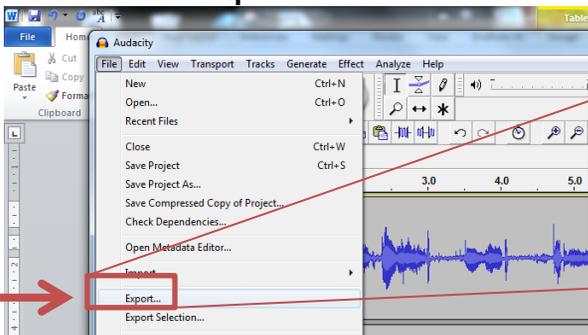
Cut Copy Paste

- To **merge tracks**, simply cut/copy from one track, click at the end of another track, and paste.

## Saving (exporting) your recording

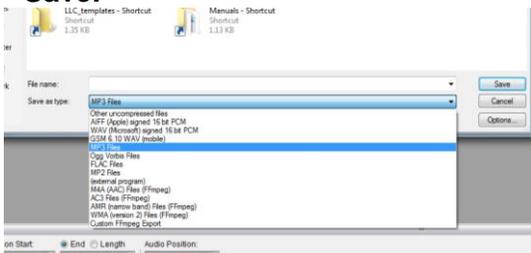
To save your track in a transferable format, you will have to **Export** it:

1 Go to **File** → **Export...**



2 **Navigate** to the folder you want to save the track in (your personal folder or a USB flash drive).

3 **Name the file** and **select mp3** as the file type from the drop-down list, then click on **Save**.



4 Optionally, add metadata details like title, your name, when the recording was made etc. This is for your future reference.

5 Once saved as an mp3, you can send your recording to anyone as an **email attachment**.

## Using Audacity at home – it is easy!

- Go to <http://audacity.sourceforge.net> and follow the easy installation instructions.
- You will also need to install an encoder file called **lame\_enc.dll** to export (save) files in an mp3 format. There is information on this on the download website, or you can ask LLC staff for help.
