

Using language software at the LLC

Why use language software?

- To **practise** your language skills, including your pronunciation, in a **fun** and **interactive** way in your **own time**.
- To **monitor** your **progress** and **receive** instant **feedback**.
- To gain **practice** and **confidence** through **recording** and **listening** back to your **own voice**.

Where can I access language software?

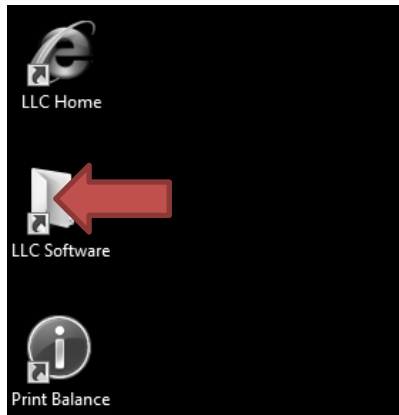
- Language software is **only available on LLC computers** and cannot be accessed elsewhere.
- For some software, the LLC has a limited number of licences – e.g. only 5 students can use it at any one time.
- Most software is **pre-installed** on LLC computers, so you can simply launch them. However, **some require CD-ROMs**, available from behind the counter (the computer will tell you if a CD-ROM is needed).
- If you have trouble accessing, launching, or using language software, talk to LLC staff.

How do I know which language software is best for me?

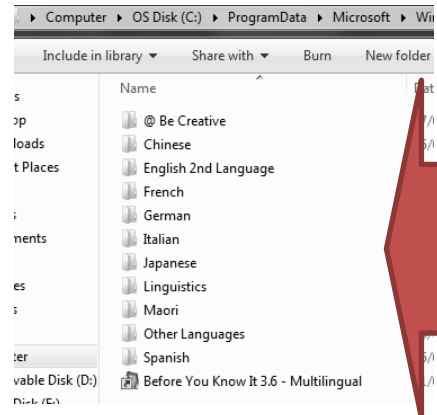
Browse the **language software catalogue** or ask LLC staff if you are unsure.

How to start using language software

1 On the desktop, click on LLC Software



2 Click on the folder of your language



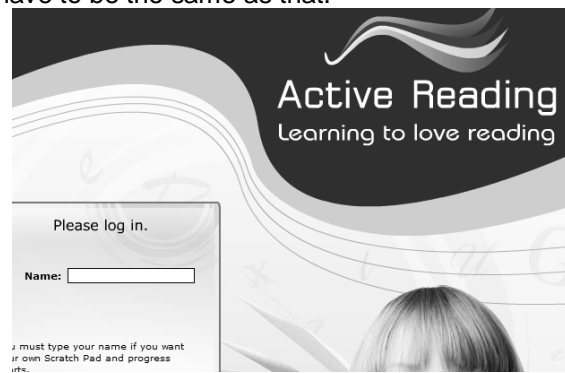
3 Click on the software icon to launch

Note: some software programmes will ask for a CD-ROM before they can launch.



4 Start learning!

Note: some software programmes will ask you to create a username for logging in. This is not related to your Victoria username and does not have to be the same as that.



Tip: If you want to track your progress from one session to the next, take note of the computer's number and make sure to launch the software from the same computer every time.
