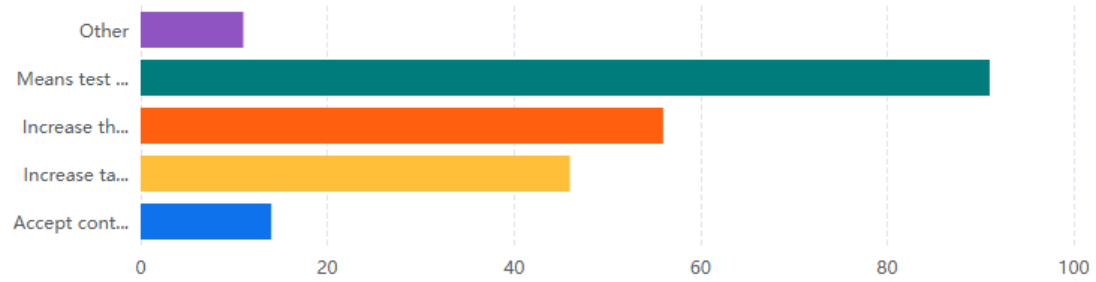

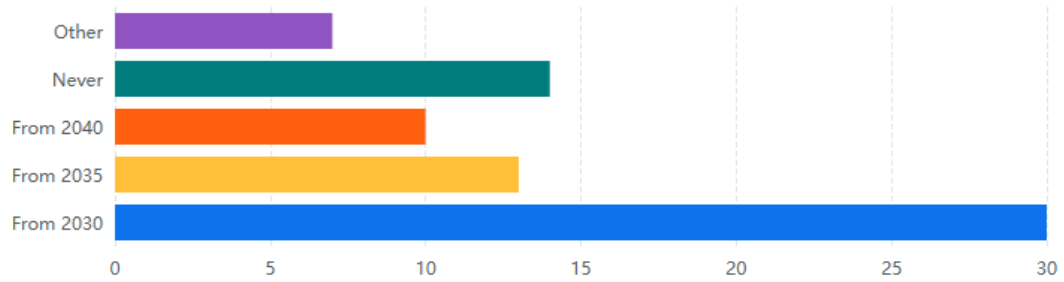

3. When should NZ increase the pension age for New Zealanders to 67? (Single choice)



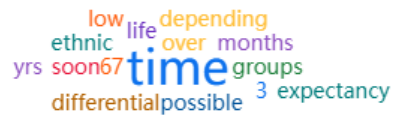

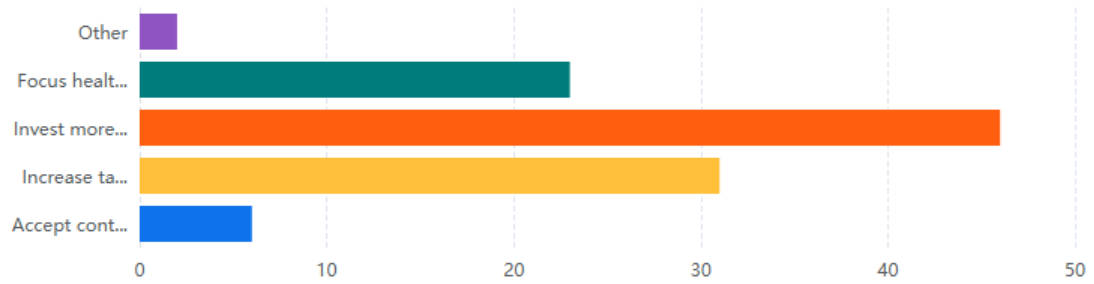

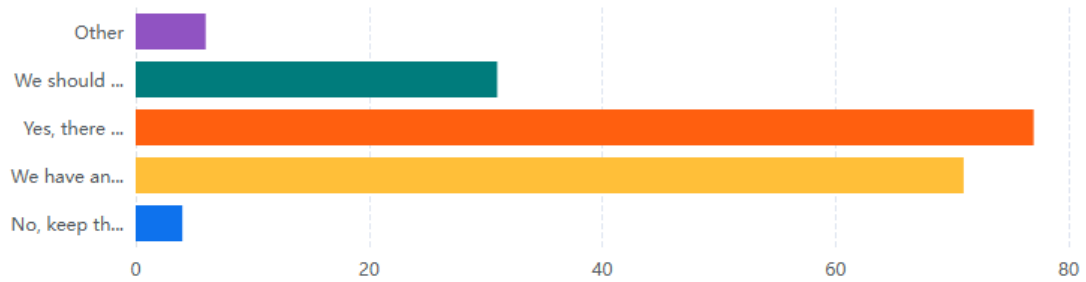

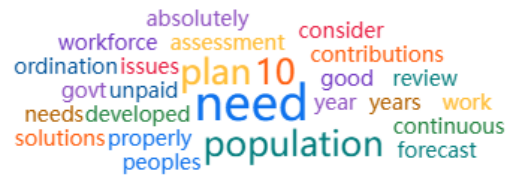

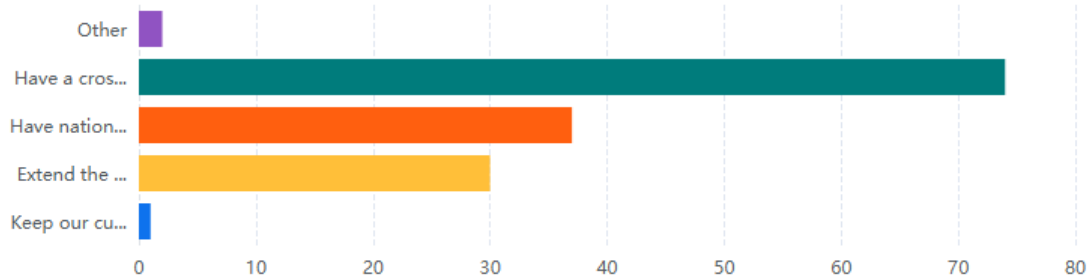

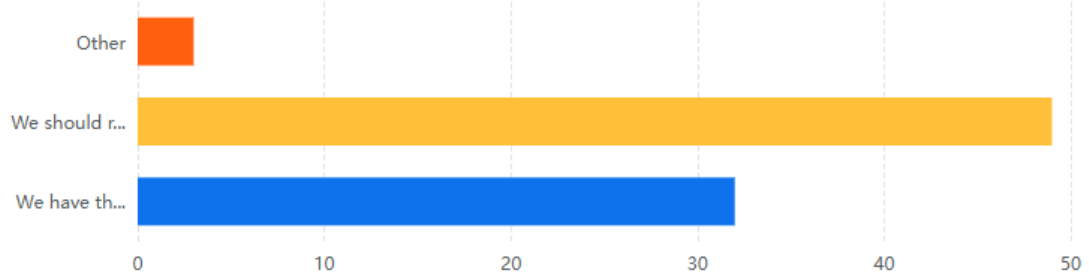
